Spectrum’s outpatient treatment centers provide a range of individual, group, and family counseling services to clients at various stages of recovery. All sites offer medication for opioid use disorder (MOUD) and alcohol use disorder (AUD), including methadone and naltrexone (Vivitrol) to reduce relapse, lessen withdrawal and prevent overdose. Buprenorphine (Suboxone) induction is available in our Milford, Weymouth, and Pleasant Street, Worcester sites. All MOUD programs include mandatory counseling sessions.
